Restaurants & Bars

A tantalising choice of restaurants....

- L'Olivier – year round Mediterranean cuisine indoors or on the terrace (open for breakfast, lunch and dinner from 6.30am to 11pm)

Buffet breakfasts with freshly made Tunisian flatbreads - “tabounas”; relaxed Mediterranean lunches and à la carte dinners. The speciality is the twice-weekly seafood buffet, The Fisherman’s Supper.

- Li Bai – delicacies of China (open for dinner from 7pm to midnight)

Serving a large selection of authentic dishes every evening, the restaurant is enhanced by elegant Chinese décor with red lacquered seats, delicate porcelain, *objets d’art* and calming music

- Zembra – light and relaxed cuisine (open for lunch and dinner daily, April to October from 10am to 5pm and from end of June to September, from 9am to midnight)

Guests can choose the catch of the day from the restaurant’s aquarium or enjoy an Italian pizza or pasta dish by the pool. The restaurant is shaded by a wooden canopy and in the evening there is live music to relax to under the stars

- El Dar- traditional Tunisian cuisine (open for dinner from 7pm to 11pm)

El Dar offers the warmth and hospitality of a Tunisian home with a menu of traditional dishes and the aromas of “shishas” bubbling away. Weekly, from June to September, dinner takes place in the gardens under a Khima (Bedouin tent) – guests can relax on poufs and kilims with belly dancers arriving to get the evening going. Open Friday and Saturday evenings year round and daily during school holidays

- Néroli – serving Mediterranean well-being cuisine (open for lunch and dinner from 10am to 11.30pm)

Adjoining the spa and serving light, nutritional dishes. In the spring and autumn the restaurant opens its terrace so guests can relax under the shade of parasols. Open daily from November to June

- The Sea Club (open for light snacks and refreshing drinks from 9am to 6pm)

Open daily from mid-May to mid-October serving light snacks and thirst-quenching drinks on the hotel’s private beach

- Le Salon (open for drinks and snacks from 8am to 1am)

Thick rugs and wood-beamed ceilings make Le Salon the perfect place for a morning cappuccino, afternoon tea or evening cocktails with a live pianist

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Les Thermes Marins de Carthage

Tunisia is known for its traditional therapies and The Residence Tunis is one of Europe's leading thalasso destination spas. The space is inspired by the magical atmosphere of ancient Roman thermal baths and spreads across 4,000m². There are 30 treatment cabins, an oriental hammam, two terraces and a majestic cupola covering a recreational seawater swimming pool.

The extensive treatment range – thalassotherapy and medical cures - use modern and ultra-efficient equipment. The team of multilingual specialists (doctors, hydrotherapists, physiotherapists, fitness staff) are on hand to explain each treatment in detail. Fitness classes and aqua sessions are held daily.

The spa is open every day from 9:30am to 7pm. Access to the water course, saunas, the hammam and the fitness room is free to hotel guests until 9pm, but not authorised for children under the age of 15.

Golf

The new Golf Performance Academy launched in Autumn 2012. Available for everyone, the programme has been designed to enhance and complement the hotel's golf course and offer mental, technical and physical training for golfers of all levels.

The 18-hole golf course, designed by Robert Trent Jones II, has an idyllic setting between the sea and salt lake and commands stunning views over the Tunisian landscape. In the heart of a natural reserve, where migrating birds and wildlife abound, the par 72, 6,451m long course has intricate fairways designed to push golfers to the limit.

The club offers golf clinics, private lessons, golf buggy and club rental, a grass driving range with 80 spots, two putting greens, two pitching greens, two practice bunkers, a pro shop with Lacoste and Titleist brands, a full caddie service, course refreshments, its own restaurant, bar, lounge and swimming pool.

A free shuttle service is organised between the hotel and golf club (a 3 minute drive)

Kids Club

Available for children aged three years to 12 years, a dedicated team of multilingual staff are on hand to organise and supervise a full programme of activities.

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Hotel Activities

Boat trips, watersport activities, horse-riding, quad biking and camel riding can all be arranged for an additional cost. The nearby shopping mall, The Gammarth Centre, has 47 boutiques to explore.

Excursions can be arranged to explore the historic Medina of Tunis, which is UNESCO World Heritage protected; the ruins of Carthage and the 13th century village of Sidi Bou Said, recognisable for its blue and white houses, wrought iron sculpted doors and the Ennajma Ezzara Palace. Nearby there are the orchards of Cap Bon, the vineyards of Mornag and Kelibia, the Ichkeul Lake, Berber potteries, the Bread Museum in Nabeul and a host of other archaeological sites, museums and Mosques.

Meetings & Events:

The fully-equipped business centre provides a complete range of services including a multilingual secretary, computers, colour printers, scanner, translation service, binding service, AV equipment and technical assistance. There is wide choice of private rooms which can host between 15 to 300 guests or delegates. A dedicated and experienced team are on hand to organise any event or meeting from beginning to end.

General Information

The Climate:

Northern Tunisia is typically Mediterranean, with hot, dry summers and mild winters. Temperatures in July and August can reach 35°C+, with up to 12 hours of sunshine every day. The best seasons to visit are spring and autumn when average temperatures are 26°C. Winters are mild but have the highest rainfall.

Lightweights in summer, medium weights and rainwear in winter.
